

Kindergarten Supply List



- 1 Backpack (**no wheels**)
- 1 LARGE zippered pencil pouch (*see picture below*)*
- 4 Boxes of **24** Crayola Crayons (**no twistables and must be a box of 24**)
- 1 Metal scissor (**Fiskar's, No Sharp Ends**)
- 8 Glue Sticks
- 20 Sharpened #2 pencils
- 1 Set of WIRED headphones (**no ear buds or Bluetooth connection**)
- 1 Ream of white copy paper
- 1 Primary Composition Notebook (*Please see picture below*)*
- 4 White HI-Polymer Eraser
- One ½" 3-Ring View Binder, **Black** (**Binder must have pockets and a clear view pocket on the outside**)*
- 1 Clear Binder Pouch (*See picture below*)*
- 1 LCD Writing Tablet, 10-11 inch*

Students are **highly encouraged to bring a device with a charger** to class daily to enhance the learning experience. Examples of types of technology that can be used are Windows laptops/tablets, Mac laptops, Android tablets, and iPads.

LARGE PENCIL POUCH

Pouches should resemble picture. They must be large enough to comfortably fit crayons, pencils, glue, dry erase marker, and eraser.



CLEAR BINDER POUCH

Pouches should resemble picture. These pouches will be used for money collection. They must be clear or see-through. Pouches must have 3 holes in order to clip them inside the binder.



PRIMARY NOTEBOOK

Primary Notebook should be similar to this. If possible, choose notebook that has white illustration space above the lines.
